FORM 1

SOCIETY ACT CONSTITUTION

- 1. The name of the society is: Pueblo Partisans Society
- 2. The purposes of the society are:
 - (a) to advance education among indigenous peoples of Latin America, the Caribbean and North America through training programs, workshops, student exchange programs and other charitable educational activities;
 - (b) to conduct research on the socio-economic nature and structures of indigenous communities in Latin America, the Caribbean and North America; and
 - (c) to relieve poverty and suffering within economically challenged indigenous communities in Latin America, the Caribbean and North America.
- 3. The society shall be carried on without purposes of profit for its members or directors, and any profits or other accretions to the society shall be used in advancing its purposes. This provision is unalterable.
- 4. In the event of the dissolution or winding-up of the society, the remaining assets, after payment of all debts and liabilities, shall be transferred to another charitable organization or a charitable foundation in British Columbia or elsewhere in Canada as the members determine. This provision is unalterable.

BYLAWS

1. The bylaws of the society are those set out in Schedule B to the Society Act.
